General Information

- High school serves ~1400 students
- 8:30 AM start time. 8:40 AM start time for nearby Rancho Elementary School
- 2 students reported being hit by a car in the last year
- Many students walk some distance to school: some students take the bus and walk from S. Novato Blvd, some drive and park and then walk.

Arthur Street

- Bike lanes end about three blocks west of school, at Tyler St
- Narrow ~4' sidewalks on both sides of Arthur Street. Wide ~8' sidewalk adjacent to the campus and in some other areas.

School Parking Lot

- large number of vehicles making a left turn to enter the parking lot results in long queues for westbound Arthur St during the morning
- Students walk through parking lot with no defined route. Limited, disconnected pedestrian/accessible routes marked
- No defined drop off zone. Some students dropped off on Arthur Street cross street randomly outside of a crosswalk. Students being dropped off in the parking lot near entrance driveway can conflict with other entering vehicles
- Faded arrow pavement markings in parking lot providing conflicting information and can be confusing to drivers
- exiting vehicles on Arthur St conflicts with entering vehicles
- Separate, back parking lot for staff only, accessed by separate service driveway. Service driveway also used by some students walking and by bikes to access the bike storage areas





Hayes Street

- Poor visibility between drivers and people trying to cross the street
- Existing pedestrian crossing signs, and speed feedback sign for westbound approach
- Cars speed through intersection
- Frequent accident spot
- Closest Crosswalk to the school



Cambridge Street


- Large volume of vehicles results in long queues at this all-way stop controlled intersection, particularly for the westbound approach in the AM, backing up to the S Novato traffic signal and blocking traffic
- Long queue of cars on northbound Cambridge Street from vehicles trying to bypass queues on S Novato Blvd
- Lots of students walking, often don't efficiently cross intersection and can prevents some vehicles from entering the intersection
- This intersection also sees elementary school students heading to Rancho Elementary to the north. Traffic overlaps in the afternoon in particular
- Neighbors complain about students waiting to be picked up
- This intersection used to have a crossing guard for the Rancho students





S Novato Boulevard

- Queue of cars from Cambridge Street blocks vehicles on S Novato, resulting in long queues for both the northbound left turn and southbound right turn movements
- Southbound right turn vehicle queue blocks bike lane
- Intersection doesn't clear quickly and some turning vehicles can be stuck in intersection after the green light ends, blocking the crosswalk, bike lane, and other lanes of traffic





Washington Street

- Pedestrian route from Washington Street through the back of campus. stairs, non-ADA complaint. No defined pathway through field, can be muddy
- a heavily used pedestrian route
