Active Green and Green Trips / Enrollment

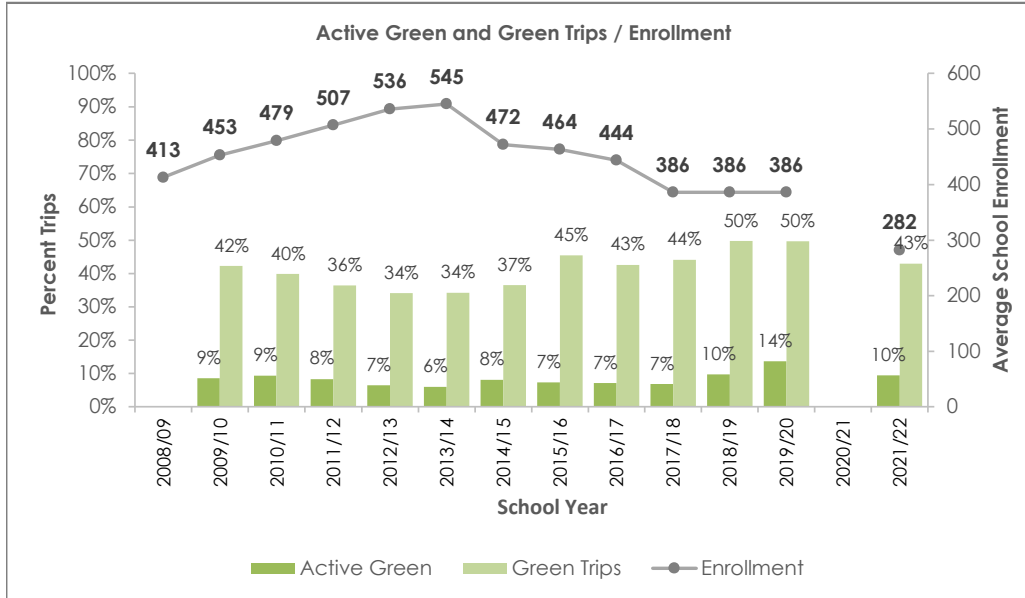

# **APPENDIX C: Education & Encouragement Programs**

# Safe Routes to Schools 2019-2022 Education & Encouragement Program Classes & Activities Descriptions

## Education

### Poster Art (All Grades)

This class prepares children for a school's individual promotion of "Walk & Roll to School" days/event. The lesson reviews the benefits of walking and biking and the simple steps to staying safe. Children make signs to carry or place at staging areas and in front of schools. Making these signs gets kids excited about the event and equips them with a device that makes them more visible in traffic.

### Second Grade: Pedestrian Safety

In second grade, Safe Routes to Schools teaches safe walking with an emphasis on crossing the street. The curriculum serves as an introduction to the safe practices that students will learn throughout elementary school and beyond.

#### [Stop, Look, & Listen - Presentation \(Part I of a Two-Part Series\)](#)

Via a fun video featuring ASIMO, a friendly robot, students cover the basics of pedestrian street safety, focusing on crossing the street. Next, a Q & A highlights neighborhood safety and the importance of "Stop, Look, and Listen" before crossing a street

#### [Walk Around the Block - Experiential \(Part II of a Two-Part Series\)](#)

In a miniature walking field trip, Walk Around the Block takes the class to a quiet street outside the school. After a review, students practice crossing the street in small groups with supervision. The walk also teaches students how to safely navigate driveways and cross the street mid-block.

### Third & Fourth Grade Bicycle Safety

Safe Routes to Schools' third and fourth grade lessons introduce bicycle safety, focusing on rules of the road. The curriculum covers the benefits of biking, how to check and fit a bike and helmet, and how to safely ride in traffic. The fourth grade two-part course includes a "bicycle rodeo" in which students have the opportunity to practice skills on the blacktop.

#### [Pedestrian & Bicycle Safety – Presentation \(Third Grade\)](#)

Students cover walking and biking beginning with a recap on walking safety. Bike safety skills are introduced, including proper helmet fit and bike fit, how to check a bike for safety, and riding predictably and responsibly.

#### [Bike & Traffic Safety - Presentation \(Fourth Grade, Part I of a Two-Part Series\)](#)

This classroom lesson begins with an introduction to the health and environmental benefits of cycling. Students learn proper helmet and bike fit and how to check a bicycle for safety. The class also covers key traffic laws and best practices for staying alert and riding predictably and responsibly.

### [Bicycle Rodeo - Experiential \(Fourth Grade, Part II of a Two-Part Series\)](#)

Held outdoors on the school's blacktop, the Bike Rodeo's three-to-four stations review key points from the classroom and address basic cycling skills like starting and stopping, navigating obstacles, and obeying the rules of the road. Students rotate between stations, practicing bike handling skills and the rules of the road on mock streets. Designed to accommodate varying skills, this lesson is both fun and confidence-building.

### Elementary School: Family Biking

Family Biking is taught to both parents and students together. League of American Cyclists-certified instructors teach basic bike skills, rules of the road, effective communication, and proper equipment in addition to gauging a child's readiness for road riding. An optional family bike ride on neighborhood streets is included.

### Sixth Grade: Bicycle Safety

Building on prior lessons, students learn in the classroom and on the bike, with an emphasis on understanding traffic laws and riding confidently.

### [Drive That Bike - Presentation \(Part I of a Two-Part Series\)](#)

A PowerPoint illustrates the benefits and responsibilities of bike commuting, plus a brief look at bicycling's history and social impact. An interactive component covers laws that govern cars and bikes. Students learn how to be visible, predictable, and mindful when riding on roads and multi-use pathways.

### [Bike Drills - Experiential \(Part II of a Two-Part Series\)](#)

Held outdoors on the school's blacktop, students first learn how to properly check a bicycle helmet for safe riding. Students then rotate between stations, practicing bike handling skills and the rules of the road on mock streets. Designed to accommodate varying skills, this lesson is both fun and confidence-building. Students are requested to bring their own bike and helmet; a small number of bikes and helmets are available for students unable to bring their own.

### High School: Share the Road

Share the Road teaches high school students the laws and safe practices governing road behavior, focusing on the rules and responsibilities for pedestrians, cyclists, and motorists.

### [Share the Road – Presentation \(Ninth through Twelfth Grades\)](#)

With a data driven approach, students learn the common causes of crashes leading to injury and death, and how most collisions can be avoided by being visible, predictable, and following the rules of the road. The class focuses on best practices for crossing the street, riding bicycles on roads, and beginner driver safety awareness.

### Middle and High School: On-Road Bike Field Trips

Students build upon prior classes by getting hands-on practice outside of school campuses.

### [Bike Field Trips – Experiential \(Middle and High School\)](#)

Safe Routes to Schools instructors can lead school-organized field trips by bicycle or host an after-school bike field trip for middle and high school students. The educational rides lead by League Certified Instructors provide hands-on experience following the mandatory Drive That Bike Presentation and Bike Drills practiced on a blacktop prior to the ride.



## Assemblies

### [Pedal Power \(Elementary School\)](#)

Pedal Power is a 20–30-minute assembly designed to educate students on the rules of the road and the importance of active and green transportation, with a focus on personal health and safety. The message is delivered in a creative, interactive performance with six fourth and fifth graders playing key roles. The assembly provides school-wide visibility, encouragement, and motivation.

## Additional Presentations / Activities

### [Sustainable Transportation – Presentation \(Middle School\)](#)

The Sustainable Transportation presentation introduces students to transportation’s environmental impact. Students are given fact-based science and data to show how local and global transportation choices impact climate change and human health. The presentation ends with an interactive and engaging game to reinforce knowledge learned in class.

### [How to Ride a Bus \(or SMART Train\) & Transit Race - Experiential \(High School\)](#)

How to Ride a Bus and Transit Race introduce high school students to the benefits and adventure of public transit. Students form teams of up to four students and travel by bus to designated locations indicated on a map. Students earn points by taking selfies at designated locations, and the team with the most points wins the competition.

### [The True Cost of Transportation – Presentation \(High School\)](#)

In this presentation, instructors introduce students to the benefits of active and shared travel to mitigate the true costs of transportation. The costs of transportation include health and environmental impacts of oil and manufacturing, the costs of parking lots and roadways on taxpayers, the costs of owning a car and more.

### [Poster Art \(All Grades\)](#)

This class prepares children for a school’s individual promotion of “Walk & Roll to School” days/event. The lesson reviews the benefits of walking and biking and the simple steps to staying safe. Children make signs to carry or place at staging areas and in front of schools. Making these signs gets kids excited about the event and equips them with a device that makes them more visible in traffic

### [No Idling Campaigns \(Middle and High School\)](#)

Often school pick-up time is when long lines of idling cars are seen waiting to pick up students. Safe Routes works with students to host campaigns to remind parents to “turn the key and be idle free” when waiting for their student. Students are taught to track the cumulative impact of idling cars at school and to use that emissions data to inform parents to turn off their engines.

### [Route Mapping \(Middle and High School\)](#)

Led by Instructors, students are asked to identify their walking and biking routes to school on an enlarged map. Students also report safety concerns along those routes to schools. This information is then used to create suggested routes to school maps that are vetted by traffic engineers.

*Bridge the Bay (Middle and High School)*

Safe Routes Teen Coordinators engage high school students for Bridge the Bay, an event to celebrate cycling and community spirit for families living in the Canal area of San Rafael. Students assist the Bay Area Bike Mobile mechanics to repair bikes for local residents. The event also includes games and activities culminating in a decorated bike parade along the Bay Trail to the Richmond Bridge.

## Encouragement

### Events

#### [International Walk to School Day \(iWalk, All Grades\)](#)

Held on the first Wednesday in October, this annual event has been taking place each year in the fall to raise awareness of the need for walkable communities, promote clean air, and encourage children to be more active.

#### [Walk & Roll Wednesdays \(Elementary School\) and Teens Go Green Days \(Middle & High Schools\)](#)

Walk and Roll Wednesdays and Teens Go Green Days are weekly or monthly events that encourage students to walk and bike to school through rewards and outreach. These events are the main activities that instill the Safe Routes to Schools program as part of the culture of each school. During Walk and Roll Wednesdays, parent volunteers host a greeting table with food and/or rewards for students who walk or bike to school. Walking School Buses or Bike Trains can also be organized to encourage groups of students to travel together. Go Green Days are events hosted by middle and high school students with teacher and Safe Routes staff support. Often students will select special themes for their monthly events such as “Cocoa for Carpools,” “Walk-O-late,” “Do-nut Drive,” and “Have a Heart.” The setup and regularity of the events vary according to the school and the availability of parent/teacher volunteers and student leaders.

#### [National Bike to School Day \(All Grades\)](#)

On the first Wednesday in May each year, kindergarten through twelfth grade students are invited to host National Bike to School Day with incentives and/or food given out at morning welcome tables to participants. National Bike to School Day is part of “Bike Month” to encourage people to commute by bike. Walkers and bus riders are invited to participate to equitably be inclusive of all students.

### CONTESTS

#### [The JEDI Challenge \(Elementary & Middle School\)](#)

The JEDI (Joyful, Excited, Devoted, Imaginative) Challenge is a new month-long contest to embed the habit of walking, biking and carpooling to school. Students are given a challenge card that serves as their raffle ticket at the end of the contest. Parent volunteers host a welcome table once per week for a month. Every time a student walks, bikes or carpools to school, the student receives a stamp on their card. Students who have four stamps on their card at the end of the contest are entered into a drawing to win raffle prizes.

#### [Pump It Up Contest \(Elementary & Middle School\)](#)

The Pump it up contest provides schools with a chance to promote walking and rolling to school immediately following the Safe Routes Bike classes. Physical Education teachers track their classes’ daily travel mode for two weeks. The class with the most walkers and rollers at the end of two weeks wins a popsicle party.

#### [Bike Hero Award \(Elementary & Middle School\)](#)

Each May, parents, administrators, teachers, and friends are invited to nominate a student Bike Hero. A Bike Hero is any student who gets up early to ride regularly, inspires others to bike, eagerly rides as a passenger on a cargo bike, obeys all rules of the road, and has fun biking.

#### [Buddy Up Contest \(Elementary & Middle School\)](#)

The new fall Buddy Up Contest encourages students to find other neighboring students to walk, bike, carpool, and ride the bus together. Students who travel to school together benefit from increased visibility. Plus, their choices are more likely to be sustainable with friends. Parents are invited to nominate the Buddies for a chance to win a group prize.

#### [Art & Poetry Contest \(Elementary & Middle School\)](#)

Safe Routes gathers students' inspirational ideas showing the benefits of walking and rolling safely to school by hosting county-wide Art & Poetry Contest. The artwork collected countywide has often been used in poster designs for events such as International Walk to School Day and National Bike to School Day.

### Other Activities

#### [Bike Blender Events \(All Grades\)](#)

Students enjoy pedaling smoothies on the Bike Blender brought to events to encourage more walking and rolling to school. The Bike Blender has been used to reward classrooms for their success in traveling to school using green modes and to foster awareness of active green travel.

#### [Park and Walk Campaigns \(Elementary School\)](#)

Safe Routes supports Park and Walk campaigns with schools eager to reduce traffic congestion and increase safety for all student arrivals. The purpose is to raise awareness of places where parents can park and walk partway with their student to campus.
